CALL TO ORDER Chairman Brown called the Public Hearing for Ordinance Number 2002-136 to amend Sections 708 (c) and 708 (d) of the Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance relating to sidewalks and curbs to order at 7:37 p.m. The location of the meeting is at the Carroll Township Municipal Building, 555 Chestnut Grove Road, Dillsburg, Pennsylvania.

INTRODUCTION Chairman Brown stated this is a public hearing to receive public comment on Ordinance Number 2002-136. Chairman Brown opened the floor for comments.

PUBLIC COMMENT Jere Rutherford asked if the amendment is going to replace the existing ordinance or is it an add on. Dianne Price stated it is a replacement and that sidewalks and curbs will be required unless waived by the Board of Supervisors. Mr. Rutherford asked why the statement “unless waived by the Board of Supervisors” is there since it is not part of any other ordinance. Mr. Rutherford also asked if the rest of the section would remain.

The Board suggest that “unless waived by the Board of Supervisors” be removed and this amendment only applies to 708(c)1 and 708(d)1.


Gary Lenker asked how would this amendment affect a development that would have curb and sidewalks on the front and rear property line. The Board stated that the developer could ask for a waiver.
