Mr. Robert Grimm, prior Tax Collector, would like to donate the records of his first four years as Tax Collector to the Dillsburg Area Historical Society (1958, 1959, 1960, and 1961). He is requesting that the Board pass a resolution to do this.

The Board of Supervisor is requesting that Mr. Grimm be contacted to see what is in these books. If delinquent taxes are part of these books, it is possible they cannot be donated but destroyed. Solicitor Stine will look into the legal issues and get back to the Board.

Brad Pealer – 90 Spring Lane Road – is still waiting for the e-mail from Victor Banks. Since he has no response from the Township he is speculating the request has been denied. He is filing an appeal before the Board of Supervisor under the Federal Freedom Information Act. Solicitor Stine commented that the Township does not fall under the Federal Freedom Information Act. The appeal was returned to Mr. Pealer.

Deana Weaver – 47 Dogwood Lane – again is asking that Resolution 2006-07 adopting the Comprehensive Recreation and Park Plan be revoked in concordance with all the documentation that has been already submitted once. Mrs. Weaver is back tonight again to resubmit all the documentation again. The resolution itself states the project is complete. Mrs. Weaver states she has a letter from Victor Banks from May 9, 2006. The last paragraph states once the comments are addressed (23 comments from August 2005) and included in the draft final plan, the changes are usually sent to DCNR for concurrence before the final plan is printed. Carroll Township made copies of the final plan and circulated the copies with no

notification to DCNR. May 16, 2006 she received a letter from DCNR stating they received the Final Plan, but the plan and project is not complete. Mrs. Weaver did receive a copy of the e-mail from Victor Banks to Dianne Price. She stated that Mr. Banks did not understand why the e-mail was not shared with them. In the e-mail from Mr. Banks addressed to Mrs. Weaver dated July 28, 2006 it states that no letters or documentation has been submitted to DCNR to address corrections or comments requested. Mrs. Weaver questioned how a third party, referring to Supervisor Brown from Franklin Township, can get documentation from sources that Carroll Township cannot get. This is again the Grant Agreement. Mrs. Weaver handed all of her documentation stated above to Chairman Faulkner.
