

NORTHERN REGION JOINT MUNICIPAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

ROAD NAME: State Highway 194/ Broadway Street (SR-0194)
MUNICIPALITY: Franklin Township; Franklinton Borough; Carroll Township

Broadway Street/State Highway 194 (SR-0194) is a two-lane collector roadway located within Franklin Township, Carroll Township and Franklinton Borough. The roadway is approximately 2.6 miles in length and runs in a north-south orientation between the intersection with SR-0074 and the Franklin-Washington Township line. The roadway provides a straight alignment, slightly rolling topography, sufficient travel lanes and shoulders, and an average pavement cross-section of 22 to 42 feet. Parking area is provided on both sides of SR-0194 within Franklinton Borough. The posted speed limit varies from 35 to 45 MPH. Average daily traffic volumes range from 3,862 vehicles per day south of Franklinton Borough to 4,752 vehicles per day at the intersection with Carlisle Road, SR 0074.

The crash history for State Route 194 reports a total of 30 crashes during the 5-year period from 1995 through 1999. This equates to a crash exposure rate of 1.51 crashes per million vehicle miles traveled, slightly less than the statewide average crash rate for roadways of similar character (1.70 crashes per million vehicle miles traveled).

Field observations and discussions with municipal personnel identified the following roadway deficiencies on SR-0194:

- Utility poles approximately 1 foot behind shoulder;
- Cracked Pavement;
- Sight distance problem at intersection with Cabin Hollow Road, Franklinton Borough;
- Sight distance problem at intersection with South Street near the Post Office, Franklinton Borough.
