On Thursday, April 19, 2007 - Ten staff members from Messiah College participated w/ CCSG in the 2007 Great PA Clean Up effort in Carroll Township. The volunteers covered nearly 5 miles of roadways and collected a total of twenty-seven bags of debris, including eleven of recyclable materials. (Approx. 250 lbs)



October/November 2008 LOGAN MEADOWS "MESS"

Removed debris from a foreclosed development (on Pimlico Road) known as Logan Meadows. Commercial Hauler dumped a full container because developer, Altieri, hadn't paid invoices. Worked w/ DEP and Township and make hauler bring back container and developer fill. CCSG picked up surrounding areas and blown debris not recovered by developer. Several lots contained abandoned and deteriorating building materials.
